Breast Cancer Screening

Mammogram for women aged 40-70 years once in two years.

Service Providers to include Tariff Code S3605 for Radiographer & S34100 for Radiologists on all Breast Cancer Screening Claim Submissions



Cervical Cancer Screening

Pap smear test for women aged 25 - 55 years once in two years.

Service Providers to include Laboratory Code S4543 on all Cervical Cancer Screening Claim submissions



Prostate Cancer Screening

Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) test for men aged 40 years and above once in two years.

Service Providers to include Laboratory Code S4519 on all Prostate Cancer Screening Claim submissions
